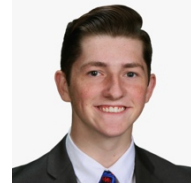


MICAH WOLF - #11

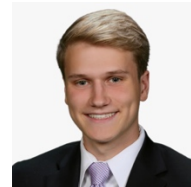


TY BANACH - #12
